Notes for John Jay Knox:

In 1811, John Jay Knox moved from Montgomery County, New York to Oneida County to settled in Cook's Corners, which later became Knox Corners and finally Knoxboro in 1863. He was a successful merchant and banker. He owned one of the largest general stores in Oneida County, New York. He was a co-founder of the Bank of Vernon, and served as its president until 1862. He also owned and had interests in several other businesses. John Jay Knox was also active in the New York State Militia. He was appointed brigadier general in 1826 by Governor DeWitt Clinton. In addition to his commercial and military pursuits, he also served on the Board of Trustees at Hamilton College from 1828 to 1876. For thirty years he was the Senior Trustee and President of the Board. He was a powerful and influential man. He was twice a presidential elector: once for William Henry Harrison and once for Abraham Lincoln (second term).

Notes for Sarah Ann Curtis:

Sarah Ann Curtis(s) was descended from many of the most ancient families of Connecticut. For example she was descended from Thomas Curtis(s) (1594-1681), who was one of the original settlers of Wethersfield, Connecticut; from John Curtis (1577-1640) who was one of the original settlers of Stratford, Connecticut; from John Parmelee (1612-1687), who was one of the original settlers of Guilford, Connecticut; and from Adam Hurd (1611-1672) who was also one of the original settlers of Stratford, Connecticut. Other families from whom she was descended are: Allan, Beardsley, Burr, Deming, Edwards, Goodrich, Gould, Grumman, Hinman, Kimberly, Plaine, Thompson, Tuttle, Woodruff, and so on.

Notes for James Curtis(s) Knox:

James Curtis(s) Knox built his home on the same plot of land in Knoxboro as his father, John Jay Knox, and James spent his entire life there. James C. Knox engaged in active and successful mercantile and manufacturing business. He and others established the New York Lock Company in 1861 and manufactured locks for several years. James C. Knox was the first postmaster of Knoxboro after the office was established in about 1850. An interesting note: In 1862, James C. Knox issued private notes for 5 cents, 10 cents, 25 cents and 50 cents, which were good in his store.

Notes for William Eaton Knox:

William Eaton Knox graduated from Hamilton College in 1840, and pursued his theological studies at Auburn Theological Seminary from which he graduated in 1843. In 1844, he was ordained pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Watertown, New York in 1844, and in 1848 of that in Rome, New York. In 1870 he accepted a call from the First Presbyterian Church at Elmira, New York, where he continued for the rest of his life. He was a trustee of Hamilton College, 1876-83, and received the degree of D.D. from there in 1865.

Died-In Oswego, N. Y., December 17, 1890, Charles Rhodes, in the 75th year of his age. The above announcement will be received with deep regret, not only in this city, but throughout the State. For several years the friends of Mr. Rhodes have noticed the encroachments of age and the evidence of declining life. In March last, Mr. Rhodes was stricken by paralysis, from which he only partially recovered. About two weeks since he suffered another stroke, and it then became apparent that the end was near. For several days he lay unconscious, and at five o'clock this morning he passed away so peacefully and painlessly that "They thought him dying when he slept, And sleeping when he died."

Notes for John Jay Knox Jr.:

John Jay Knox, Jr. graduated from Hamilton College, New York in 1849. He began his business career as a clerk in the bank at Vernon, New York, of which his father was president. He was subsequently, for brief periods, cashier of a bank at Norfolk, Virginia and of one at Binghamton, New York. He conducted a private banking business at Saint Paul, Minnesota with his brother, Henry M. Knox, 1856-62, and in January, 1862, he wrote an article for Hunt's Merchants' Magazine advocating the establishment of a national banking system, with the circulation guaranteed by the government. This article attracted the attention of Secretary Chase, and Mr. Knox was given a position in the U.S. Treasury Department. His suggestion resulted in the national bank act, passed Feb. 25, 1863. He had charge of the mint and coinage correspondence in the Treasury Department, 1866-73, and made an examination of the U.S. branch mint at San Francisco. His report was published in 1866. He subsequently discovered in the Office of the Treasury of the U.S. mint at New Orleans a defalcation of \$1,000,000. and he took charge of the branch. He was Deputy Comptroller of the currency under Secretary McCulloch, 1867-72, and he was Comptroller, 1872-84. While Deputy Comptroller he prepared a bill for the discontinuing of the coinage of the silver dollar. With the help of the director of the mint, on June 25, 1870, he reported the bill with the opinion of scientific experts to Congress, and it was ordered printed. In 1873 Henry R. Linderman used this bill, and the opinions attached, as the basis of the "Coinage Act of 1873". Mr. Knox was made an ex officio member of the assay commission in recognition of his services. He accomplished the sale of the 3 percent bonds. He was president of the National Bank of the Republic, New York City, 1884-92; the Republican candidate for Comptroller of New York City, 1887; a member of the finance committee of the New

York Chamber of Commerce; a trustee of Hamilton College, 1884-92; a member of the American Banking Association, of the Union League and University Clubs, and of the Century Association. He received the honorary degree of L.L.D. from Hamilton College in 1890. On Jan. 16, 1890, he made an elaborate argument in favor of a permanent national bank circulation before the banking and currency committee of the U.S. House of Representatives. He is the author of: Annual Reports of the U.S. Treasury (1872-1884); United States Notes: or a History of the Various Issues of Paper Money by the U.S. Government (1894); and A History of Banking in the United States, left incomplete and published by his wife.

Notes for Henry Martyn Knox:

Henry Martyn Knox graduated from Hamilton College in 1851. He attended Auburn Theological Seminary from 1851 to 1852, but he was never ordained. Rather, Henry entered business in Saint Paul, Minnesota. For ten years he was the chairman of the Central Committee of the Minnesota State Social Security Association. He then became the Public Examiner of the State of Minnesota. In addition, he was an elder in the Dayton Avenue Church in Saint Paul. In 1898, he lists his residence as Paterson, New Jersey and his occupation as Banker. In the 1900 U.S. Census, he is shown as living in Dedham, Massachusetts with his wife, Charlotte, and his mother-in-law. (Charlotte had been born in Massachusetts.)

Notes for Charles Eugene Knox:

Charles Eugene Knox attended Hamilton College and received an A.B. degree in 1856 and an A.M. degree in 1859. He attended Auburn Theological Seminary from 1856 to 57 and graduated from the Union Theological Seminary, New York City, in 1859. He was licensed by the presbytery of New York in 1859, was a tutor at Hamilton College, 1859-60; was acting pastor of the Reformed Church, Utica, New York, 1860-62; stated supply at Oswego, New York, 1862-63; at Morristown, New Jersey, 1863-64; and was ordained by the presbytery of Newark, New Jersey, June 8, 1864. He was pastor of the First Presbyterian church at Bloomfield, New Jersey, 1864-73.

In 1869, Rev. Charles E. Knox founded the German Theological Seminary of Newark, New Jersey under the auspices of the Presbyterian Church. The roots of the College and its mission can be traced back to 1868. With the influx of nearly two million German immigrants following the European Revolution of 1848, it became necessary to establish a training school for German-speaking ministers. In 1872, the school relocated to Bloomfield, New Jersey, occupying the home of the former Bloomfield Academy at Franklin and Liberty Streets. That structure stands today as Seibert Hall. Knox Hall was erected in 1914 to commemorate his work there. Charles E. Knox was the President of German Theological School for 30 years, until his death in 1900.

He received the honorary degree of D.D. from the College of New Jersey in 1874. He is the author of: Year with St. Paul (1863); Love to the End (1868); David the King (1874); a course of graded Sunday school text books in five numbers (1864-67); and reports, sermons and pamphlets.

Notes for Sarah Fake:

According to the 1900 U.S. Census, Charles and Sarah Knox had 14 children, of whom only five were still alive in 1900. There seem to have been two boys who

died at birth, one in 1878 and another in 1881.

"Carel Hansen Toll [was] an early and large proprietor of Schenectady N.Y., who first settled at Hoffman's Ferry on land purchased in 1684 from Hendrick Cuyler and Geraldus Cambefort and afterwards removed to Maalwyck where he died 1737-8. Carel Hansen Toll came from Norway and appears to have been a seafaring man, who had had adventures on the Spanish main. He seems to have been taken prisoner and to have escaped from the fortress of Puerto Bello where he was confined and to have reached a departing ship by his strong and dexterous swimming. For this he received from the Indians the name of Kin-ge-go-a fish. In Daniel Toll's Narrative there are many stories told of this very original character. He was a member of the Provincial Assembly for Albany Co., 1714-1726. On one occasion going to the Assembly in a rather shabby coat he said cheerfully when remonstrated with "never mind it has a good lining." He married Elizabeth daughter of Jan Rinckhout of Albany and Eva Juriaans, his first wife. Pearson calls Elizabeth daughter of Daniel Rinckhout, brother of Jan. Daniel appears by his will to have been unmarried and an old agreement dated 1734 mentions Elizabeth as daughter of Jan Rinckhout."

Carel Hansen Toll was born about 1660 in Albany, Albany County, New York to Hans Carelsen and Leentje Cornelis Van Moerkercken Toll or Neeltje Cornelise Egmont Toll. He was a seafarer who had many adventures, one time earning the nickname Kingego, meaning fish, from the Indians when he swam to freedom from a fortress at Puerto Bello where he was being held prisoner and reached a departing ship. He was fairly wealthy, first settling at Hoffman's Ferry in Schenectady, New York. At one time he owned all the land along the north bank of the Mohawk River from Verf Kil on the east to Eva's Kil at Crane's Village on the west. Carel married Lysbeth Janse Rinckhout in 1685 at Albany, Albany County, New York and their children were: Eva, Neeltje, Daniel, Simon, Abraham, Brechtje and Lysbeth. He was a member of the Provincial Assembly for Albany County from 1714 to 1726. On one occasion arriving at the Assembly in a shabby coat, he cheerfully replied when criticized, "never mind, it has a good lining." Carel died March 1737 in New York, probably the Albany-Schenectady area, and is presumed buried there.

John Parmelee, Jr: (1612-1687/88):

John Parmelee, (whom we are going to call John, Jr.) was baptized Sept. 6, 1612, at All Saints parish, Lewes, England, and died Jan. 31, 1687/88, in Guilford, Connecticut. He was the first member of the Parmelee family to immigrate to America, arriving four years before his father. "Jo. Palmerley" was listed as a 22-year-old passenger on the *Elizabeth and Anne*, which left London on April 13, 1635, and arrived at the Charlestown section of Boston late that spring or early summer. According to a posting on ancestry.com, which appears to be a paraphrase from *Whispers From The Hills*, by Nicholas W. Humble, "Family legend says that the Captain (Roger Cooper) offered a reward for the first person to spot land, and John, according to family legend, was the first to spot land and received a reward, paid in gold. The 1635 arrival date would make the Parmley name one of the oldest in the new world. It is recorded that on the Elizabeth & Ann, there were 23 passengers, all of quality, all orthodox, all vouched for by the minister of "Ye Church of England," and by the local town justice of the town from which they had come." No other family member was listed on the Elizabeth & Anne's roster but it makes sense to assume that he was accompanied by his wife Rebecca (maiden name may have been Eaton) Parmelee, whom Jim Walters claims he probably married in England. They had only one child:

-- Nathaniel Parmelee, born in 1645, married Sarah French on Oct. 24, 1668, died in 1676. (See next generation)

John Parmelee, Jr. was one of the original settlers of Guilford, Connecticut, his first home lot being a 1.5-acre parcel on the east side of Crooked Lane, the fourth lot north of Buck Lane. John Parmelee, Jr.'s name appears in Guilford's town records, being sued in 1648 by a fellow planter who complained that John's hogs had rooted through his corn. He took the oath of freeman in Guilford on Feb. 14, 1649/50, a little less than a year after his father did. He became the drummer of Guilford's train band, the colony's chief defense unit, and served as sexton for many years, "warning" settlers to meetings and church services by beating his drum. His wife Rebecca Parmelee died Sept 24 or 29, 1651, in Guilford, Ct. That same year, 1651, John Parmelee, Jr., married Anna Plaine/Plain (1600*-1658), the widow of William Plaine,* in Guilford. William, another signer of the Guilford Plantation Covenant, had been executed in 1646 in New Haven after having been found guilty of sodomy and "corrupting boys." John and Anna had no children.* Anna was buried March 30, 1658, in Guilford. A year or two before that, John Jr's name appeared in Guilford Town Records again for reporting to train band practice while intoxicated on Jan. 1, 1656/57: "a common fame or report of his inordinate drinking upon a Trayneing day of late, appearing in his gestures et&c. ..." Testimony shows that he managed to upset pails of water set out at a couple neighbors' homes with his drum. He was fined.

John's third wife was Hannah Plaine/Plain (1638-1688), the daughter of William and Anna Plaine/Plane (and, therefore, John Parmelee, Jr.'s stepdaughter), whom he married in February 1659. They had nine children, all born in Guilford, Ct.:

-- John or Jonathan Parmelee, born Nov. 25, 1659, died March 21 or 27, 1725, at Guilford, married Mary Mason on June 27, 1681, at Guilford. His tombstone can be seen at Guilford's Alderbrook Cemetery. He had 7 children.

-- Joshua Parmelee, born about 1661, died in June, 1729, in Guilford, married Else/Else/Alice Edwards* on July 10, 1690, at East Guilford; and widow Hannah DeWolfe Stone in 1716, at Guilford. He had 13 children -- 8 with Else and 5 with Hannah. In addition, Hannah had five children by her first husband, Benajah Stone (1674-1714).

-- Caleb Parmelee, born about 1663, probably died in 1741, married Abigail Johnson (1665-1692) on April 11, 1690, at Guilford. They had one child before she died in 1692. He married 2nd, Abigail Hill* (1664-1737) on April 23, 1693, at Guilford, with whom he had six children, and 3rd, Mary Durham (1670-?) on Jan. 11, 1737/3 [NOTE: Many old genealogies state that he died in 1714, but Jim Walters believes that these last two digits have been transposed, for he can be found buying and selling land with Caleb Jr. from 1724 to 1740. There has been some confusion about Mary Durham, who is sometimes listed as Caleb Jr.'s third wife, rather than Caleb Sr.'s, but Caleb Jr.'s estate papers refer to Jemima as his widow.] Caleb (Sr.) moved to Branford, CT.

-- Isaac Parmelee, born Nov. 21, 1665, died Jan. 13, 1748/49, at Guilford, married Elizabeth Hyland/Highland (1666-1746) on Dec. 30, 1689, at Guilford. Their home, the Hyland House, still stands east of the green at Guilford. He had 9 children.

-- Hannah Parmelee, born Nov. 5, 1667, died 13 Jan. 1746 in Guilford, married Tahan Hill* (1659-1692) in November 1688. He died four years later, leaving her with two children. She married 2nd, Thomas Merrill on May 25, 1693, at Saybrook, CT., and moved to Saybrook. She and Thomas Merrill had 3 children.

-- Stephen Parmelee, born Dec. 6, 1669, died April 4, 1736, at Newtown, CT., married Elizabeth Baldwin (1673-1702) on June 20, 1693, at Guilford. He moved to Newtown, CT., where he was the town drummer. They had 10 children.

-- Job Parmelee, born July 31, 1673, died March 6, 1765, at Guilford, married Betty/ Elizabeth Edwards* (1680-1761) on March 11, 1699, at Guilford. They had 7 children.

-- Priscilla Parmelee, born May 8, 1678, died Dec. 10, 1692, at Guilford.

-- Joel Parmelee, born about 1679/80, died July 20, 1748, at Durham, CT., married Abigail Andrews (1683-1769) on June 30, 1706, at Durham. Moved to Durham. His tombstone was found at Durham's Old Cemetery near the top of the hill. They had 10 children.

Hannah Plaine Parmelee died Jan. 8, 1687/88, at about the age of fifty. John Parmelee, Jr. died January 31, 1687/88, three weeks after Hannah, at the age of 76.

John Jr.'s 10 children make up the major branches of the largest North American Parmelee family. He had at least 74 grandchildren. Our line descends from his first child, Nathaniel Parmelee, born of John Parmelee, Jr.'s first marriage to Rebecca.

The will of John Parmelee Jr. of Guilford, Conn., dated Dec. 20, 1684, disposed of property inventoried on Feb. 8, 1687/88, at 259 pounds, 4 shillings, and is signed with his mark. After leaving his widow (who was, by that time, deceased) 20 pounds, he divided his home lot between sons John and Joshua; gave his land in Nut Plains, an area just north of the central village, and several other parcels to John; and gave Joshua the land in Nut Plains that he had purchased from John Goodrich. He gave sons Caleb and Isaac 5 pounds each; daughter Hannah 2 pounds; son Stephen 7 pounds, and his other children -- Job, Priscilla and Joel --10 pounds each. He also designated that his youngest sons would receive land on the Great Plain when they reached 21, and his daughter, when she reached 18. His oldest child, Nathaniel, preceded him in death.

*Notes:

-- Anna Plaine Parmelee's supposed birthdate (1600) seems far too early, considering that her 1st husband William Plaine was born (supposedly) in 1615 and John Parmelee in 1612. John Parmelee's birthdate is far more credible than either Anna or William's.

-- If William and Anna had no children, who is Hannah Plaine's father?

-- Joshua Parmelee's wife, Else Edwards, and Job Parmelee's wife, Elizabeth Edwards, were sisters, both daughters of Thomas Edwards (1647-1698) and Abigail ? (1644-1680).

-- Caleb Parmelee's 2nd wife, Abigail Hill (1664-1737), and his sister Hannah Parmelee's 1st husband, Tahan Hill (1659-1692), were siblings, both born to Luke Hill (1613-1696) and Mary Hoyt (1635-1692).

-- Hannah Parmelee Hill Merrill moved to Saybrook, CT. Stephen Parmelee moved to Newtown, CT. Caleb Parmelee moved to Branford, CT. Joel Parmelee moved to Durham, CT. The other six Parmelee children remained in Guilford.

Cornelis Segersz van Voorhout:

In his contract with the patroon, Aug. 25, 1643, referred to as Cornelis Segertsen van egmont. Voorhout is a small place near Leyden; Egmont lies near Alkmaar. He sailed by het (the) [ship] Wapen van Rensselaerswyck with his wife, Brechtje Jacobs, 45 years of age, and six children, Cornelis, 22; Claes, 20; Seger, 14; Lysbeth, 16; Jannetje, 10; and Neeltje, 8 years of age. On his arrival in the colony, he entered upon the farm formerly occupied by Brant Peelen, deceased, which was one of the two farms on Castle Island; in 1646, he took over from Adriaen van der Donck the other farm for the remaining three years of the lease, and thus came into possession of the entire island. In an undated will, recorded between 1643 and 1648, Cornelis Segersz and his wife declare that they possess nothing; that any property which they may acquire shall go to the five children who live with them; and that the sixth child, Lysbeth, who is married, and therefore does not assist them in the acquisition of the property, shall receive as an acknowledgment one pound Flemish. At the time the will appears to have been drawn, Lysbeth was married to Gijsbert Cornelisz, from Weesp, the tavern keeper. Shortly after his death, in 1653 or 1654, she married Francois Boon.

Notes for Thomas Curtis:

Thomas Curtis was one of the original settlers of Wethersfield. He is known as "The Settler". He removed to Wallingford, Connecticut in 1670.

According to Ryan Curtis, Thomas Curtis is buried in the Ancient Burying Ground in Hartford, Connecticut (FAG #28830839). From 1640 until the 1800s the Ancient Burying Ground was Hartford's only graveyard. 6000 people are believed to have been buried there. There are about 415 stones still standing. There is also a monument to the first settlers of Hartford.

According to John Oster, writing in the Curtis/s Chronicle of June 2021, it is likely that Thomas Curtis was among the first settlers of Southold, the earliest English community to arise on Long Island. (This is, however, unproven.) (Southold is on the North Fork on the extreme eastern end of Long Island.) Oster also states: "It is possible, perhaps likely, that he had been one of a number of 'adventurers' prospecting along the Atlantic coast for pine trees from which to make naval stores---turpentine, tar, and pitch. This group made its way from Bermuda to the Carolinas and thence north, arriving on Long Island's North Fork in 1636-37."

William was born in Bury St. Edmunds, County Suffolk, England and came to America in 1635. His father was John Goodrich and his mother was Marjerie Howe Goodrich. His parents remained in England and are buried at Bury St. Edmunds in County Suffolk. Most of the Goodrichs in the USA today are descendants of William. Ensign William Goodrich, a son of John and Margerie (Howes) Goodrich of Bury St. Edmunds, Suffolk, England was baptized February 13, 1621/2 at Bury St. Mary. William probably came to America in 1635 with his older brother John and their guardian Clement Chaplin on the Elizabeth. Clement Chaplin departed Cambridge with the followers of Rev. Thomas Hooker in 1636 and came to Hartford, but settled instead in nearby Wethersfield, where he was the Ruling Elder. William Goodrich married on October 4, 1648 in Hartford, Connecticut Sarah Marvin (1631-1702), a daughter of Matthew and Elizabeth Marvin of Great Bentley, Essex. William and Sarah had 5 sons and 4 daughters, and lived out their lives in Wethersfield. William died before the inventory of his estate taken November 14, 1676, and was buried in Wethersfield Village Cemetery in a grave that probably had one of the perishable markers from that time that are no longer visible.

The probate court supplied name of another daughter, Elizabeth, wife of John Broughton of Northampton, Mass.

William Plaine (1615-1646): (John Parmelee's 2nd wife's first husband)

The story of law in the New England colonies cannot be separated from the story of religion. Unease about survival fed into a pervasive sense that God must never be displeased by aberrant behaviors, that sins against his nature would result in consequences for the entire community. Against that backdrop, the first American code of laws, drawn up by the Massachusetts Puritans in 1636, created a list of "Capitall offences lyable to death." These included treason, murder, witchcraft, arson, sodomy, rape, buggery (bestiality), and adultery. Connecticut, settled by Puritans, adopted much of Massachusetts's colony's laws, softening some aspects (excluding from punishment a partner who is raped or under 15 years of age), but a code of laws written in New Haven added masturbation to its definition of sodomy. (Perhaps in response to the William Plaine case. See the John Murrin quote below.) After the American Revolution, laws softened enough to exclude sodomy from the list of offenses punishable by death, but not by other means (imprisonment, forced servitude, forfeiture of goods, and castration). (From *Homosexuals and the Death Penalty in Colonial America*, Louis Crompton, University of Nebraska Faculty Publications, 1976)

Despite the draconian nature of the laws, few people were actually executed for sodomy, and those cases that resulted in execution were those in which there were aggravating circumstances. There were only two instances of execution for sodomy in the New England colonies. William Plaine was one of them. (From *The Construction of Homosexuality*, David F. Greenberg, University of Chicago Press, 1988)

According to the website outhistory.org, "In 1639, Plaine had been a signer of the Covenant in which the first Guilford settlers, while still aboard ship bound for New England, promised, "the Lord

assisting," to be helpful to each other "in every common work, according to every man's ability and as need shall require." They had also promised "not to desert ... each other," without the consent of the majority of the signers... Plaine was assigned a home lot of two acres, and, in 1645, was appointed by the Town Council to build the dam for the Town Mill, and to inspect chimneys as a fire precaution -- responsibilities suggesting he was a trusted resident of Guilford. But the following year various charges were brought against him."

"According to John Winthrop,* the charges were that Plaine, though "a married man ... had committed sodomy with two persons in England," and "had corrupted a great part of the youth of Guilford by masturbations ... above a hundred times." When asked about such "filthy practice," Plaine "did insinuate seeds of atheism, questioning whether there was a God."

(* John Winthrop was the Governor of Massachusetts Bay Colony.)

"Winthrop reported in his journal that Governor Eaton of the New Haven Colony had written to the governor of the Massachusetts Colony seeking the magistrates' and church elders' advice about Plaine's punishment. All agreed that he "ought to die," giving different reasons "from the word of God." Winthrop added: "indeed it was horrendum facinus [a dreadful crime], and he a monster in human shape ... , and it tended to the frustrating of the ordinance of marriage and the hindering the generation of mankind." Winthrop's reasons for considering Plaine's activities so wicked, their alleged anti-marriage, anti-procreative effects, summarized two main Puritan objections to sodomy."

"Plaine's alleged "questioning whether there was a God," and his unrepentant sexual activity, suggests an active defiance of basic Puritan beliefs and laws. " (from outhistory.org: http://www.outhistory.org/wiki/Legal_case:_Plaine_executed%3B_New_Haven,_1646)

According to John Murrin, "After the fact, New Haven adopted a law to cover the case. It declared that public masturbation, by ``corrupting or tempting others to do the like, . . . tends to the sin of Sodomy, if it be not one kind of it"; and ``if the case considered with the aggravating circumstances, shall according to the mind of God revealed in his word require it, he shall be put to death, as the court of magistrates shall determine." In short, Plaine's crime was inciting others to sodomy. .. Unfortunately the New Haven Colony records do not survive for this case, or we would have a much fuller account of how many boys were involved with Plaine. But if these encounters happened more than a hundred times, they had been going on for months before any lad notified the authorities or some respectable resident interrupted one of the frolics." (From Things Fearful to Name: Bestiality in Early America, John M. Murrin, Journal of Interdisciplinary History, Vol. 34, Number 1, Summer 2003)

It appears that the aggravating circumstance in William Plaine's case may have been his questioning of God and the Puritan order. Although, to be fair to the authorities, it is possible that they saw the crime as pedophilia, rather than simple sodomy or masturbation. ('Wickedness Breaks Forth': The Crime Of Sodomy In Colonial New England/ Kimberly N. Chehardy <http://www.loyno.edu/~history/journal/1999-2000/Chehardy.htm>) While John Murrin suggests that William Plaine's crime was inciting others to masturbation, George Painter makes a different accusation in The Sensibilities of Our Forefathers: William Plaine masturbated boys. (From Sodomy Laws <http://www.glapn.org/sodomylaws/index.htm> The Sensibilities of Our Forefathers, The History of Sodomy Laws in the United States, George Painter)

Thirty-one-year-old William Plaine was hanged in Guilford, Connecticut, in 1646. Nine years later, in 1655, John Knight was hanged for sodomy in New Haven.

NOTE: I was confused, reading through the available accounts, about whether both cases happened in Guilford, and whether William Plaine's execution was carried out in Guilford or New Haven. I also have been unable to find an exact date for Plaine's execution. Conventional histories, like the History of the Town of Guilford, mention his execution without details and with no more emphasis than a discussion of original settlers who moved on to other locations. The details I have been able to find come from relatively recent papers on the history of homosexuality in America.

Information from: <http://www.caskey-family.com/genealogy/WilliamBeardsley.htm>: William Beardsley was unquestionably of decided non-conformist principles, and resolved on emigration to America in pursuance of his religious convictions. According to the record of him at the time of his embarkation, he came to London with a certificate from the minister of St. Albans, Hertfordshire, and according to attestations from a justice of the peace, with thirty-six other emigrants sailed from London on the ship "Planter," commanded by Captain Travice, April 2, 1635. On the ship's list he was described as thirty years old, and by occupation a mason; and he was accompanied by his wife Marie, aged twenty-six, daughter Marie, four, son John, two, and son Joseph, six months.

William Beardsley was made a Freeman on 07 Dec 1636 in Massachusetts. He moved to Wethersfield, Connecticut. Then in October 1639, he moved to Stratford, Connecticut.

With seventeen others, William Beardsley set forth westward into the wilderness and founded the new settlement (seventh in chronological order in Connecticut) of what is now Stratford, Fairfield county. This place, originally known by its Indian name, Cupheag, was designated Stratford by the general court in 1643. To Beardsley has always been attributed the principal part in the selection of the name, and hence has arisen the presumption that he either came from or was in some way intimately identified with Stratford-on-Avon, Shakespeare's home in England, but this has not been established. He had the second choice of town lots, the minister, Rev. Adam Blakeman, having the first. Throughout the remainder of his life he was a conspicuous citizen of Stratford. He was one of the founders of the First Congregational Church in Stratford.

The Y-DNA test results of William's descendants match those of John's descendants, and I believe this statement refers to your ancestor John. Wish there were more!

According to the Curtis/s Family Society, "Widow Curtiss" was the first to use the last name "Curtiss" with two esses.
