

A Brief History of Mary Gibson

Mary Gibson was born on 29 December 1809 in Gilmerton, Liberton, Midlothian, Scotland. Her parents were Walter Gibson and Christina Taite. Her parents were married on 27 May 1806 in Canongate, Edinburgh, Midlothian.

At the time of his marriage, at age 28 years, Walter Gibson was a Laborer.

The Gibson family had lived in Edinburgh proper for (at least) several generations. And the men in the family had been tradesmen. However, shortly after his marriage, Walter moved to Gilmerton, about three miles, as the crow flies, southeast of Edinburgh. In 1809, Gilmerton was agricultural. Thus, it is likely that that is where he became a Ploughman, the occupation he would pursue for the rest of his working life.

As a child, Mary would have moved with her family from Gilmerton, to Newton, to Northfield, to Cauldcoats. Her youngest sibling was born in 1824, when Mary was 14 years of age.

As was the practice at that time, children left their families at about age 14 to begin to work on their own account. So it was that Mary went to work on Mortonhall Estate, Edinburgh,³ which is about four miles from Cauldcoats in Newton Parish.

While still on her own as a single woman, in 1837, at age 28 years, Mary had a child, Adam Gibson, out of wedlock.

At age 32, Mary Gibson married James Alexander on 18 Jun 1841 Liberton, Midlothian.

Mary and James Alexander had four children in addition to Adam, who James adopted as his own. Adam was born in Cauldcoats, Newton Parish. All of the other children were probably born on Mortonhall Estate.

Mary Gibson and family were typical of many farm laborers of the mid-1800s. They live a hard life but, one hopes, full of love for each other and with friendship for their fellow workers.

George Watt, Mary Gibson's great, great grandson has written a touching account of Mary and of her times.

Mary Gibson Alexander died on 25 March 1868 of cancer at Morton House. She was 52 years of age.

1841-06-18 Mary Gibson, daughter of Walter Gibson, and James Alexander Marriage Record at Mortonhall Estate in Liberton, Midlothian.

Whitsunday falls on the seventh Sunday after Easter. In 1841, that was on the 30th of May. That means that Mary and her son Adam had time to leave Morton Mains and visit her mother in Newton (a distance of about 4 miles) just in time for the 1841 census, which was taken on June 6th.

Note that the family lived in Morton Village not on the Mortonhall Estate. Walter Gibson was Mary's nephew. Note that Mary's son, Adam, is shown as "Adam Gibson" not "Adam Alexander".

1851 Scotland Census Record Elizabeth Gibson Alexander. Elizabeth was not living at home, but she, too, was living in Morton Village. Jane McKenzie is listed as being 67 years of age (which was probably elderly at that time) and as a "Pauper". Perhaps the young girl, Elizabeth, was asked to live with Jane to help her.
