I had hoped to finish the research on 28 Apl but was not able to do do. Hence another visit to York yesterday.

HILDRETH.

Searches have continued in the records of Felixkirk and the full span being given on sheet 1 of this report - which includes my report of 30 Nov last. I found a further child of Richard Hildreth - Elizabeth in 1755 - but no there in the eralier years. I also found a later child Francis and would think there could be another between Thomas and Francis, I had better have another check in this period.

The burials of Felixkirk were searched down to 1784 but I found no record of Richard Hildreth, of course if he was born about 1730 he may have lived after 1784. I realise that I have not searched the marriages and burials 1756 to 1762 in order to make a complete search.

I also found a family of Francis Hildreth, and in view of Richard having a son called Francis it may be that Richard born ca. 1730 and Francis born ca. 1725 could have been brothers.

An even earlier family of Hildreths was found in the 1720s but there was no Francis or Richard listed as sons of John Hildreth, so maybe this was another family. I see that John died in 1741 so if I search for any will and find he left one, we may find useful information.

Thirlby is a miles east of Felixkirk and Cleaves House is half a mile east of Thirlby. I could send you a map of the area if you wish.

In view of not finding the marriage of Richard Hildreth pre 1755 at Felixkirk, I then tried other parishes and a chapelry in the area, but all were negative I am sorry to

say. I also searched the records of the same parishes and chapelry in an effort to find if Richard Hildren had any other children baptised or buried in them, but again the result was negative.

I am now able to send you a photocopy of the marriage bond of the 1780 Hildreth-Barwick marriage.

BARWICK.

Searérches have continued in the regords of Stokesley for any further Barwick christeings (sheet 2). Two further siblings of the ancestral Ann were found, and one would think there could have been another child of James' born ca. 1760-61

I also searched the marriage of Stokesley for that of James Barwick pre 1755 but no such was found back to 1748. A_search was made for this marriage, and that of Richard Hildreth pre 1755 in the I. G. I. of Yorkshire. Nothing was found for Richard Hildreth although I did find one for a James Barwick in 1750. I have my doubts if it will be relevant as Broughton by Skipton is about sixty miles south west of Stokesley.
